**Course Title:** Radiology Review for the Dental Professional

**Course Description:** This course is designed as a review of the basic radiation principles, techniques, quality assurance and safety measures utilized by the dental team when exposing patients to x-radiation as required by the Department of Environmental Protection Bureau of Radiation Protection document number 291-4200-001.

**Course Objectives:** The Participants will be able to:

1. Research the current FDA and ADA guidelines regarding patient and operator safety.
2. Understand the basics of radiation production and biologic effects.
3. Describe methods of patient and operator protection during dental diagnostic exposures including proper use of radiographic guidelines, proper radiographic techniques, safety measures (inherent, added, and digital), quality assurance techniques and infection control.
4. Provide up to date information for patient education concerning the benefits and types of radiographic examinations as well as safety measures utilized to keep radiation exposure to a minimum (ALARA).
